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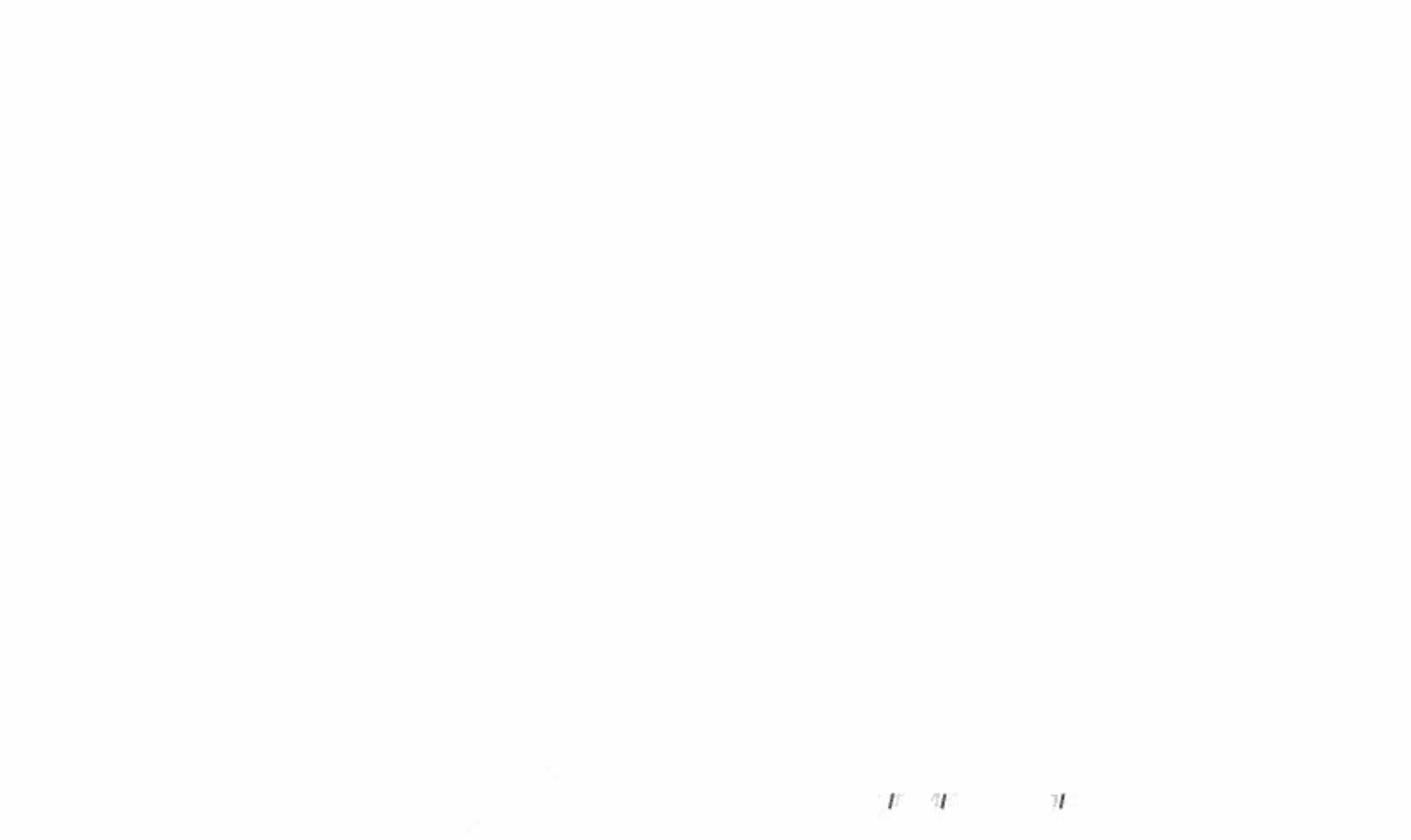
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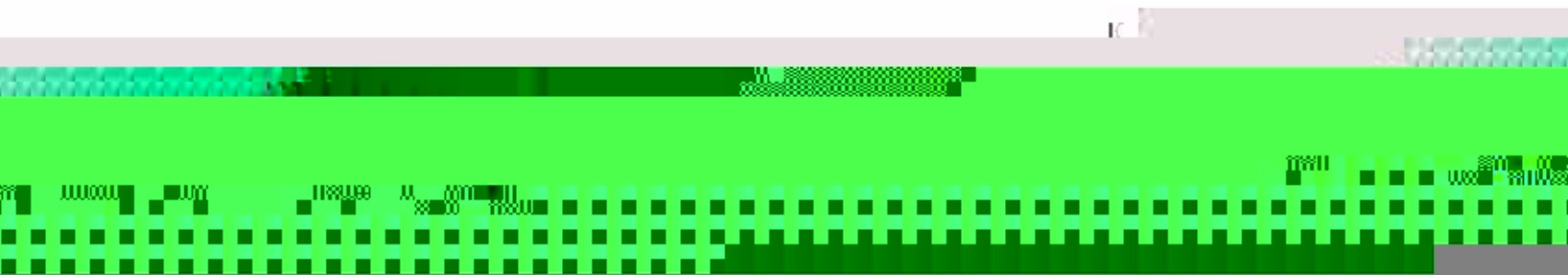

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the following procedure shall be followed for the review of a protocol submission

1. All protocols must be submitted to the Biosafety Committee for review

2. The Biosafety Committee will review the protocol and determine if it is acceptable

3. If the protocol is approved, the investigator must complete the required training

4. If the protocol is not approved, the investigator must revise the protocol and resubmit it

5. The Biosafety Committee will notify the investigator of the outcome of the review
